Introduction

The Museum aims to bring the stories of the Broads alive. Situated by the river, at the historic Stalham Staithe, at the Northern gateway to the Broads National Park, there is plenty of space for visitors indoors and outside. Plus, we offer boat trips. It's the ideal introduction for visitors to the Norfolk and Suffolk Broads.

What we offer

- Drop off/pick up on site and free parking for a coach at Richardson's boat yard, about 200m from the Museum.
- Exhibits, activities, film, and displays tell stories of the Broads from Roman times. Meet Broads characters and the local wildlife, discover iconic boats, marvel at tools used to work the landscape and build boats, and find out about the unique Broads landscape and plans for a sustainable future.
- 2 passenger boats offer 30-minute wildlife spotting cruises with commentary. Falcon is our steamboat, and Marsh Harrier, our wheelchair accessible electric boat.
- Guided tours around the Museum give more information with that personal touch!
- Cream teas and panini (to be confirmed) plus a small café selling drinks, snacks, and confectionary.
- Large outside picnic area by the river.
- Shop selling souvenirs and Broads themed books and gifts.
- Accessible toilets.

The Practical stuff

A trip to the Museum is ideally for half a day. As we carry 12 passengers on Marsh Harrier and 10 on Falcon, we suggest dividing visitors into groups and running the boat trips and guided tours at the same time.

Museum entry: £7 per adult, 30 mins boat trip: £7. Combined ticket: £12 for coaches when booked in advance. To include a guided tour when required. Free entry to shop and café. Free entry for driver plus a free hot/cold drink.

We are open from 24 March to 03 November, on Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and holiday Mondays, 1000 – 1600, but may open especially for a coach tour if required. For more details and to book, please see the website or contact the Administrator:
